#### Description of System:

The Blue Rivers Transportation System operates in Jefferson County, Nebraska on a demand-response, portal-to-portal basis. We require 24-hours advance notice to schedule rides. All transit services are available to the public, including persons with disabilities. Vehicles are stationed in Fairbury. Surrounding community routes are scheduled on an as-needed, once a week basis.

The Inter-City (West) route provides transportation to Lincoln.

#### Days and Hours of Operation:

##### Monday through Friday:

8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Route times 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and return 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

**Monday:** Service from Fairbury to Daykin, Alexandria, Powell, and Gladstone if requested (includes return to Fairbury).

**Tuesday:** Service from Fairbury to Hubbell, Reynolds, and Thompson if requested (includes return to Fairbury).

**Wednesday:** In Fairbury.

**Thursday:** Service from Fairbury to Endicott, Steele City, and Diller if requested (includes return to Fairbury).

**Friday:** Service from Fairbury to Jansen, Harbine, and Plymouth if requested (includes return to Fairbury).

#### Rate Schedule:

\$3.00 for one-way trip within community

\$6.00 per one-way trip between communities

\$12.00 one-way trip to Lincoln

#### Number of Vehicles:

2 12-passenger buses (lift equipped)
